Why should you monitor?

Monitoring is the most important part of the Sentricon® Colony Elimination System.

Monitoring aids us in finding termite activity on the outside before the termites become a problem on the inside. Monitoring allows us to place the bait only in stations with termite activity.

An ounce of prevention equals long-term peace of mind.

While Sentricon is an extremely effective treatment method, it is also an early warning device. Consider it a permanent security system. Because there are on average 8-12 colonies per acre in this part of the country, this is a very important part of the system. When a new colony attacks, you will be covered through a continuous protection plan. Please refer to your service agreement for more details.

As long as you continue the Sentricon system, you can count on the system to protect your home

from termite infestation today and in the future. And now, your monitoring service can be paid with a monthly bank draft, at no interest. Call the office for more details.

How do we monitor?

When monitoring we check all of the stations quarterly. When needed, we change the monitoring devices and clean out the stations. We even replace any station that we cannot find or that has been damaged (hit by lawnmower or damaged by an animal) at no extra charge.

What happens when we have termite activity in the station(s).

When we have activity in a

station, we start baiting the station. Also, we install an additional station next to the baited station.

Once we have eliminated the termite colony, the site is cleared of all additional stations. The permanent stations are cleaned and the monitoring devices are replaced. The monitoring of the site will continue on a quarterly basis.

Homeowner tips:

One of the major problems we have is finding the station(s). When home owners want to change their landscape or mulch, we ask that you don't remove any stations or cover them to the point we cannot

find them. This would help us find and eliminate the termite colonies as fast as possible.

Before you start any new construction projects (decks, retainer walls or home additions), please call to confirm if there is or isn't any termite activity in the location.
