FARMVILLE-HAMPDEN SYDNEY LINE:

Received of Virginia Public Service Company, hereinafter called COMPANY, the sum of \$20.00, in consideration of which the undersigned, hereinafter referred to as OWNER, do hereby grant unto the said COMPANY, a right of way upon which to construct, maintain and operate an electric distribution line, including poles, wires, crossarms, brackets, anchors, guys, braces and other apparatus, and to attach thereto its telephone wires and fixtures and the wires of any other company or person, over and across the following property: to-wit:

A tract of approximately 1000 acres of land situate in Farmville Magisterial District Prince Edward County, State of Virginia, adjoining the lands of R. P. Armistead & J. L. Putney, The approximate route of said right of way is as follows:

Beginning at a point on the property line between R. P. Armistead and Owner; thence in a southerly direction across the property for approximately 700 feet to a point on the property line between Owner and J. L. Putney.

Also the right is hereby granted to said Company, at all times, when necessary, to trim, cut or remove any or all trees or other obstructions that might endanger the lines, so as to clear the wires, crossarms and other fixtures erected thereon, by at least Ten (10) feet, with the right to cut dead or danger trees off the right of way which in falling may strike the line, together with the right of ingress and egress to and from said right of way.
