

- (b) Get a broom or stiff brush and remove all loose pieces of paint from walk, woodwork, window welk and ceiling:
- (c) Sweep up all pieces of paint and plaster and put them in a paper bag or wrap them in accuspliper. Fut these packages in the trash case. DO NOT BURN THEM:
